The U.S. Embassy/Banjul is seeking an experienced individual with the required work permit for employment in country for the position of an **Electrician** in the Maintenance Section of the General Services Office. Under the general supervision of the Maintenance Supervisor, the incumbent will perform skilled electrical installation and repair jobs and other semi-skilled and unskilled maintenance work at U.S. Government owned or leased buildings.

REQUIRED QUALIFICATIONS:

NOTE: All applicants are instructed to address each selection criterion detailed below with specific and comprehensive information supporting each criteria.

Education: Completion of secondary school is required. Training or apprenticeship in trade is required.

Experience: Two years of experience as an electrician is required. Work with a major organization required.

Knowledge: Must have knowledge of appliances, generators and large building electrical systems found in the mission, including proper preventative maintenance procedures. Basic knowledge of electronics required.

Language: Level II English ability (limited knowledge) is required.

Abilities/Skills: Must be able to resolve a wide variety of electrical problems quickly and independently. Must be able to follow instructions carefully and work well with a team.
